**ORDER TO CALL A SPECIAL MEETING

Pursuant to the authority granted by Utah Code § 10-3-502, we, the undersigned members of the City Council for Vineyard City, Utah, hereby call for a special meeting of the council to address urgent matters requiring immediate consideration and action.

1. Purpose of the Special Meeting:

The purpose of this special meeting is to discuss and take action on the following item(s):
Official Meeting Agenda:

Each citizen will be given roughly 3 minutes (more if needed but be brief) to share their city priorities for the year. Each citizen will be asked to take a post-it note after speaking and write down their 2-3 suggestions for the city agenda. These two nights are to inspire conversation and open dialogue. Here are a few (but not all areas) you could offer feedback.

1. Citizen-Centered Decisions - ideas to Empower Vineyard residents to shape our city's direction. This is an Open topic. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved and added in the 2024 city agenda.

2. Use of Consultants and lobbyist: What is working? What isn't? Share your opinions and priorities. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda.

3. Integrity and Transparency- we are asking for 2-3 policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda.

4. Strengthening Core Services - bring 2-3 ideas on improvements of current city services. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda.

5. Council and Mayor Accountability. Bring us 2-3 ideas on how we can be more transparent and accountable. We aren't perfect. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda.

6. Responsible and Controlled Growth - share 2-3 ideas on things you feel we are missing with growth.

7. Parking Solutions - Address parking concerns to enhance convenience and accessibility for residents and visitors. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda. Please come with 2-3 brief ideas you would like to see changed.

8. Learn from Mistakes - bring 2-3 mistakes you feel we need to remediate. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda.

9. Prioritize Vital Infrastructure - we would like to know your top 2-3 projects in the city. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in the 2024 city agenda.

10. Inclusive Dialogue - we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved on inclusive dialogue in the 2024 city agenda. We are here to learn about their experiences in the city and adjust policy to their needs. Don't lecture or censor them. Do you like the social media changes? What is working what isn't?

11. Understanding our HOAs - Recognize HOAs as allies, We need to understand their role in managing issues that they inherited from the city. we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in our relationship with HOA's

12. Accountability: we are asking for policy ideas from citizens on what they would like improved in accountable the 2024 city agenda

13. Vineyard Garden: offer 2-3 ideas that could improve our garden.

14. Vineyard City library. Offer 2-3 ideas that could improve or change our library services.

15. Cities that Care - Offer 2-3 ideas that could improve or change our CTC program

Lastly, don't feel this is the only item citizen can speak about.

At the end of the meeting, we will ask citizens to organize the post-it notes into groups and form policy suggestions that we can submit to council.

We are looking for citizens willing to lead on key citizen suggestions. No votes or decisions can be made in these listening sessions. This is just to openly talk and gather your citizen feedback.

3. Notice:

Notice of this special meeting shall be given in accordance with the Open and Public Meetings Act. All council members, relevant city officials, and the public shall be informed of the meeting as required by law.

4. Agenda:

The agenda for the special meeting shall include the item(s) listed in Section 1 above and any other matters that may lawfully be considered at the special meeting.

5. Authority:

It is understood by the undersigned members that they cannot compel the attendance of the mayor or any other city council members, that they may not act (make a motion, vote, or adopt a motion, resolution, or ordinance) without a quorum of the city council present at the meeting, and that they may not rescind or reconsider any previous motion, resolution, or ordinance of the city council without at least as many members of the city council present as attended and voted on the originally adopted motion, resolution, or ordinance.

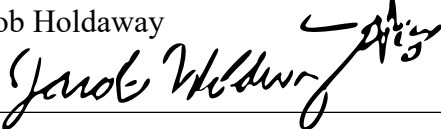
