School Commitment Program: Ongoing- Help with Number of Tardies/Pizza with the Principal was the original plan. Are schools still recognizing students for citizenship and academics? Yes. 6th grade is doing the NOVA programs and recognizing kids as SuperNovas.

Some interest in promoting a citizenship award. Need to flesh out the particulars. How often? Maybe even just focus on a certain grade. Could be something that our Community Outreach and Youth Involvement Workgroup to work on?

- Social Media Campaign
 - Anna (SM manager from the city) wants to do a SM campaign for Vineyard Cares during the month of February. 3 videos and at least 1 video that coalition members be a part of to recruit more people to join coalition. Easier to record that video before or after Feb Coalition Mtg. Julia will send a reminder in the agenda for next month. Appearance in video is optional.
- Milestones and Benchmarks (in phase 2/3 at this point in the CTC progress)

- Community Outreach and Youth Involvement Workgroup
 - 2.23: Develop mechanisms for community member involvement.
 - 2.24: Create a plan for involving youth. (maybe the citizenship award for elementary schools in Vineyard can fall under this workgroup?)
- Community Assessment Workgroup
 - 3.12: Hold Community Assessment workshop. This is something Julia will train us on. She is making short videos for that workshop.
- Data Workgroup:
 - 3.31: Identify populations with high levels of risk and low levels of protection.

Upcoming:

- Guiding Good Choices starting Saturday, Feb 1st, at 10 AM
Lee and Jessica Maxwell will be facilitating. Julia distributed flyers to all elementary schools and principals. Currently only have 1 family signed up. Julia will also reaching out to school counselors or even vice principals to increase awareness.
- Brian (parks and rec director) has asked our coalition to write a letter of support for the skate park. It has been approved in preliminary planning and a location just south of city office buildings has been designated. Funding is the issue at this point. They are applying for grants, so they need letters of support for this application process. To be in support of the park, we want to make sure it aligns with our coalition values. It brings kids together, physical activity, express creativity, social activity, etc. Julia will write the letter and send it to us to approve before submitting it. We also want to ensure safety is a priority in the building and execution of the park. Since it will be located to the police station and potentially the future fire station, we project the first responders will be involved in the project and after it opens, be there to “unofficially” monitor both the safety of the kids and the atmosphere.
