Background/Discussion:

May is National Bike Month, and our city is actively participating with a full slate of events designed to promote bicycling for transportation, recreation, and fun. We have several events planned throughout the month and ongoing activities to engage residents of all ages.

Summary of Events:

1. Bike Rodeo – May 12 at 5:30 PM

- The Bike Rodeo, originally postponed, is rescheduled for May 12. This family-friendly event will include safety demonstrations, bike skills courses, and helmet fittings.

2. Bike to School Day – May 7

- Bike to School Day was a success. Local crossing guards participated by handing out Bike Month pins to students who biked to school.

3. Bike to Work Day – May 16

- On May 16, we'll celebrate Bike to Work Day by offering free breakfast to cyclists at the FrontRunner Station. This encourages commuters to try biking as part of their daily routine.

4. Bike Story Time – May 20

- A special story time focused on bicycles will be held on May 20. This event targets younger residents and aims to promote safe cycling habits and excitement for biking from an early age.

5. Utah City Bike Tour – May 31 at 11:00 AM

- We're partnering with Utah City to host a guided bike tour on May 31. The tour will showcase bike-friendly infrastructure and points of interest. A map is currently in development in collaboration with Utah City staff.

6. Month-long Bike Scavenger Hunt

- Residents can participate in a citywide scavenger hunt throughout May. Clues and locations are released weekly through a downloadable app. Participants who complete the hunt will be entered to win the grand prize: an E-bike.

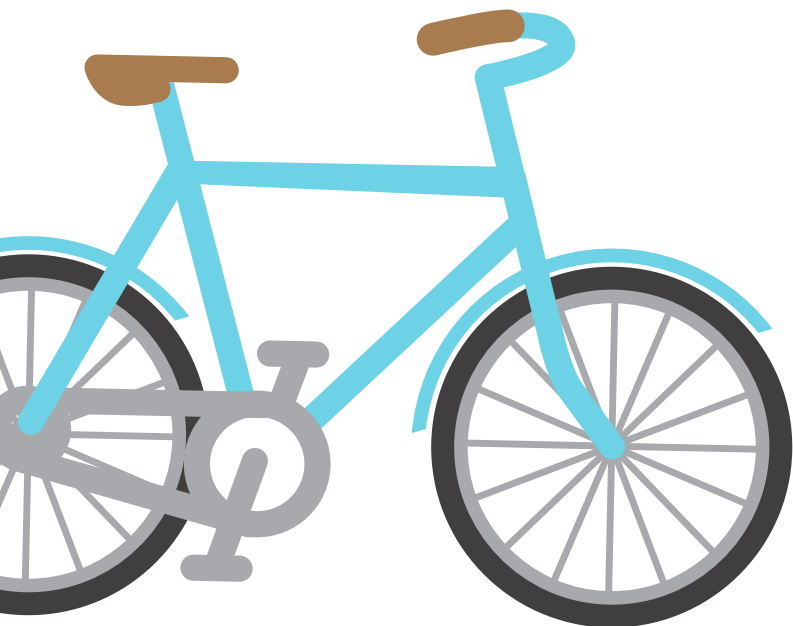

Background/Discussion:

As the Holdaway Fields development progresses, the development team continues to coordinate closely with City staff in accordance with the terms outlined in the approved Development Agreement. The project has now reached a key phase involving the design of the eastern extension of 400 South, which will include an active transportation (AT) component.

This work session is intended to engage the Active Transportation Commission in a collaborative discussion to explore design concepts and gather input on AT elements that could be integrated into the future construction of this roadway segment. While construction is not yet scheduled, preliminary design work is underway to ensure the alignment reflects the City's long-term mobility goals.

The 400 South extension will ultimately be constructed by the developer as part of their obligations under the Development Agreement. Staff will present initial design considerations and seek feedback on preferred cross-sections, pedestrian and cyclist accommodations, and any other features that support a safe and connected transportation network.

Other proposed street designs outside the holdaway fields development will be discussed.
