Background/Discussion:

Vineyard City – CPR/UORG Grant Trail Amenities Review

Vineyard City has partnered with the Utah Lake Authority to secure a CPR/UORG grant for the purchase and installation of trail amenities along the shoreline corridor.

Staff has evaluated community needs and identified potential locations for the proposed amenities, taking into consideration connectivity, visibility, safety, proximity to existing trail infrastructure, maintenance access, and overall user experience.
